As a Junior Graphic Designer, you will be responsible for designing and creating marketing materials and assets alongside both Marketing and Sales colleagues, as well as other areas of the business as required. This includes creation and development of a broad range of content, from web to videos, print to social media, as well as supporting our busy events programme as required. As this is a new role, the ability to create new templates and standards in a timely manner is critical and support will be provided to achieve this. The successful applicant will be working alongside a range of stakeholders, both internal and external, and will have the freedom to develop concepts and the role, in line with business needs.

Training will be given where necessary and all e2e-assure employees have budget available for supporting with training requirements.

Key Attributes

Essential:

- Strong evidence of design capability across a range of media.
- Demonstrable experience with design software (such as Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator and others, although software can be changed to your skillsets) - this can be non-paid work.
- Strong creative problem-solving skills.
- A willingness to take on new projects and learn new toolsets and skills.
- A good understanding of social media, websites and print media.
- Strong attention to detail.
- The ability to balance business need with design principles to achieve the organisations' targets.
- The ability to work independently and manage your time in a fast-paced environment.
- The ability to work with others, liaising and negotiating with senior stakeholders and to take and give feedback.

Desirable:

- Previous experience working as a Graphic Designer.
- Experience in video editing and animation would be beneficial, but not crucial.
- The ability to work to and support the creation of briefs.
- Experience of working alone and as part of a team.
- An understanding of website design.

Location: This is a hybrid role, primarily based from home, with the occasional need to travel to our offices in Oxfordshire. Some travel, including international, may be required.

Hours: 40 hours per week but part time options may be available.

Salary and Benefits: £25,000 starting salary, depending on experience with two 6-monthly pay reviews. 25 days annual leave, rising to 28 days over time. We also offer a contributory pension scheme, a cycle-to-work scheme, discounts on tech purchases and social events.

Process:
